<b>1. Requirements prior to admission to Teacher Education</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Minimum 60 semester hours</li> <li>b. The following education courses are to be taken. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>i. ED 300—Introduction to Teacher Education (to be taken after 32 semester hours)</li> <li>ii. EIM 300—Introduction to Educational Technology (to be taken after 32 semester hours)</li> <li>iii. SPE 300—Survey of Exceptional Children and Youth (to be taken after 32 semester hours)</li> </ul> </li> <li>c. APTT (Alabama Prospective Teacher Test)—passing score required.*</li> <li>d. 2.5 GPA.</li> <li>e. Complete an application for admission to the TEP.</li> <li>f. Complete "Letter of Understanding."</li> <li>g. Candidate interview by program committee.</li> <li>h. Three professional reference letters.</li> </ul>
<b>2. Admission to Preservice Teaching (Student Teaching)</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Minimum 2.5 all Professional Education courses, and all Teaching Field courses.</li> <li>b. English Competency Exam (ECE)—passing score required.*</li> <li>c. PRAXIS II—passing score required.*</li> </ul>
<b>3. Minimum requirements for application for certification and graduation</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. CBASE (College Base Examination).*</li> <li>b. Complete an undergraduate application for degree.</li> <li>c. Complete all certification requirements (application for certification, fingerprint card(s), required fees, and transcript request forms).</li> <li>d. Complete an undergraduate application for degree.</li> <li>e. Minimum 128 Total Hours.</li> <li>f. 52 hours 300/400 level.</li> <li>g. Overall GPA of 2.5 or higher.</li> <li>h. 64 Semester hours credit at a 4-year institution.</li> <li>i. 32 Semester hours credit at JSU.</li> </ul>
