Valedictorian Scholarships are offered to incoming first-time freshmen who are declared Valedictorian their senior year of high school. Students must meet the following criteria: United States citizen, Alabama 2015 high school graduate, and be an unconditionally accepted entering freshman. Official high school transcripts and test scores (ACT 22 or above SAT 1030 or above) must be on file at JSU prior to March 1, 2015.
