Basic Information

- Any member of the Honors Program is eligible to enroll in the study tour. Students from all majors are
 invited to participate in this Study Abroad opportunity. Students who are not yet members of the Honors
 Program must complete the online application http://jsu.edu/cas/honors/honors-program-application.html
 and be admitted to the program prior to being allowed to enroll in the Study Abroad opportunity.
 To qualify, a student must:
 - be enrolled in an academic Honors class or Honors by Contract at JSU for the Fall 2017 & Spring 2018 semesters with a final grade of B or better
 - o have a minimum 3.25 GPA
 - o enroll in UH 399 Study and Travel course for Spring 2018
- We will know exact May departure dates 80 days out. EF will be pairing us with students from other universities to provide an opportunity to get to know other students and to keep the price lower.
- Deadline to enroll is February 11, 2018 but early enrollment equals lower prices.
- Students must enroll with the name listed on their passports.
- If you do not yet have a passport, you must purchase a passport and provide a copy to the Honors Program by March 15, 2018.
- Tipping for drivers and tour guides is not included so we recommend \$20-30 per day for tipping, souvenirs, and any optional activities students may decide to participate in.
- Breakfast, lunch, and dinner will be included on days 2-8. You will be responsible for 1-2 of your own meals on both traveling days.
- Students, at their own expense, do have the option of extending their stay in Costa Rica and EF can arrange their flight home. Students will be responsible for any flight increase as a result of changes to their departure date. Students wishing to extend their stay in Costa Rica should inform the Honors Program and EF as soon as possible to secure the best pricing.

- 4. Failure to complete the Fall Honors course or contract for Fall 2017 may result in additional assignments for the UH 399 class or exclusion from the trip.
