

Case Finding

Usually cases are reported in the court report. If you know the name and the citation of the case, you can go to the following sources to locate your case:

Tax Court Reporter (REF HJ3251.A4C58)

If you do not know the case in point, you can go to one of the law encyclopedias or digests, which are compiled by alphabetic order, to find the citation of the case, and then go to the right reports.
