### Unconditional Acceptance

- 2.00 grade point average
- 20 or above on the ACT (composite)
- 950 or above on the SAT (critical reading & math)

### Conditional Acceptance

- 2.00 grade point average
- 18-19 on the ACT (composite)
- 870-940 on the SAT (critical reading & math)

### TRANSFER APPLICANTS

must submit the following:

- Application for undergraduate admission
- \$35 non-refundable application fee
- Official transcripts from each college or university previously attended

### Transfer Acceptance

- 2.00 transfer grade point average
- At least 24 hours of transferable credit
- Eligible to return to last institution attended
- Students with fewer than 24 earned hours must meet freshman admission requirements
