What is "High School Voice Day?"

This is an opportunity for the JSU Voice Faculty to coach high school singers on solo repertoire as well as provide advice on preparing for vocal auditions.

Who are the members of the JSU Voice Faculty?

Dr. Patricia Corbin, Dr. Dani Jones, Ms Teresa Cheatham Stricklin, and Dr. Nathan Wight.

Who should attend this event?

Any High School student, grades 9 – 12, who is preparing a solo for an upcoming audition such as: college entrance auditions, "Solo & Ensemble," NATS student auditions, musical theatre auditions, or any student who is just interested in having the opportunity to receive feedback from our faculty.

What will happen on the day?

High School students will rotate between voice faculty members and will have an opportunity to sing their repertoire as often as time allows. There will also be mini workshops on polishing your diction, strategies for sight-reading, preparing for pageants and "what to wear" for an audition.

Do I need to bring an accompanist?

It would be very helpful to bring your own accompanist because your accompanist will be familiar with your music, but if that isn't possible, an accompanist will be provided on a limited basis, as time and availability allows. It will be best to sing standard vocal literature and to let us know in advance what repertoire you will be performing and in what key.

May I bring a recorded track accompaniment?

No, please bring the printed sheet music for whatever song you choose to sing on the day.

What should I wear?

Please dress up for this day as you would for any audition. We will be offering advice on what to wear, so we would all be interested in what you might wear for such an occasion.

I am a high school senior. May I audition for a scholarship and/or entrance into the Music Department on this day?

Recently our audition policies have changed. Our auditions are now being coordinated by the university, not our specific department. The voice faculty can certainly hear on this day and make recommendations but your official audition should be during regular audition dates. If you have a special circumstance, please let us know and we can work something out.

Our regular scholarship auditions are Friday and Saturday, February 2, 3, 9, 10, 2018. Please sign up through the scholarship link on our music department website: www.jsu.edu/music. You must have completed the JSU admission process to be considered for a scholarship or entrance into the department.

How much does this cost?

Pre-Registration (received at JSU by Wednesday, January 24) \$5 per student

Walk In Registration, \$8 cash only

What happens if I can't attend? Are these fees refundable or interchangeable with another student?

Fees are neither refundable nor exchangeable.

May I attend this event alone? My music teacher can not attend.

All students must be chaperoned by an approved adult while on campus. It does not have to be your music teacher, but it must be someone authorized by your parent or legal guardian.
