DNP Tuition and Fees Information

If you are applying for the DNP program for Fall 2018, please pay particular attention to the information below concerning tuition and fees.

At this time, the latest information we have concerning tuition and fees for the DNP program for Fall 2018 is that the program costs are under review by the Tuition and Fees Committee and will be further reviewed by the Board of Trustees. A final decision will be made in April 2018 concerning tuition/fees for Fall 2018 admitted students.

For now, it is helpful to know how the tuition/fee plan works for DNP students. For the Fall 2017 term, Jacksonville State University offered a **ONE PRICE TUITION** plan for all DNP students, regardless of track. This meant that the <u>tuition, university fees, and</u> <u>programmatic fees would NOT increase</u> as long as the student satisfactorily progressed through the program according to their chosen plan of study. They must have continuous enrollment; any lapse in enrollment will cause them to lose the one price option and require them to re-enroll under current tuition/fee prices with no discounts.

We expect the **ONE PRICE TUITION** plan to continue for Fall 2018 with the same stipulation of continuous enrollment as indicated above. <u>If a price increase does</u> <u>occur, we expect it to be minimal</u>. For now, please review the costs from 2017-18 so that you will have a general idea of how the plan works. **PLEASE NOTE: THESE COSTS ARE FOR STUDENTS CURRENTLY ATTENDING AND ARE SUBJECT TO CHANGE BASED ON BOARD OF TRUSTEE RECOMMENDATIONS.**

2017-2018 Academic Year

BSN-DNP (to include FNP and AGACNP) - Total Cost - \$35,000

12 semester Plan of Study - \$2,916.67 per semester 15 semester Plan of Study - \$2,333.33 per semester

Post-Master's DNP – Total Cost - \$18,000

4 semester Plan of Study - \$4,500 per semester 6 semester plan of study - \$3,000 per semester

This one price tuition plan includes **ALL** tuition, university, and programmatic fees. It does **NOT** include books, supplies, and external vendor costs (e.g., Castlebranch, Typhon). Please note that if you must take a semester off, you will no longer be eligible for the one price tuition plan. At that point, you will be responsible for current fees, tuition, etc., in order to re-enroll.
