The first order of business was a discussion of the problems associated with the Spring 2004 semester that resulted in no initiation ceremony. The officers discussed the following ideas for holding initiation as soon as possible and preventing a reoccurrence of the problems of last semester.

1. The list of students, faculty, and alumni to be invited to join will be compiled early in the Fall 2004 semester to allow for ample time to coordinate all the duties involved in the ceremony.
2. The next ceremony will be held in December 2004 and will include students who graduated in December 2003, April 2004, Summer 2004, and December 2004.
3. In the future, the members of the Selection Committee will be contacted individually instead of depending on the Chair to coordinate initiation ceremony activities.

New officers must be elected soon. The previous election was held in September, but under the circumstances of the fall initiation planning, a spring election is more logical. The position of President-elect must be filled immediately due to Brenda Phillips' resignation. The officers discussed the possibility of offering to serve extended terms until the chapter is more stable. The officer situation will be discussed at the fall chapter meeting.

The PKP National Triennial Conference will be held August 2004 in New Mexico. One delegate per chapter will receive reimbursement from the National PKP Office. Franscesca Rao, student vice president, will represent JSU. The chapter will supplement the National PKP stipend to cover any additional expenses.
