



Well, we are officially into finals week. We will end finals week with the Christmas Luncheon (see below). Be sure to sign up and bring a dish to share.

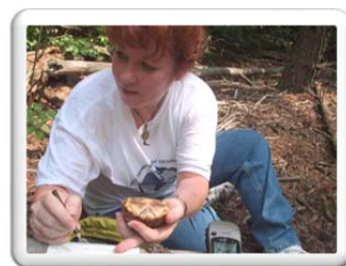

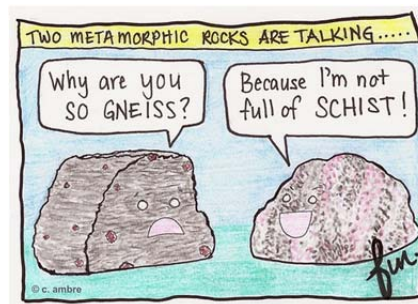

Opportunity for JSU Graduates to Study in Canada

Attention JSU students graduating before August 1, 2013! The Fulbright Canada Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math Award is a new initiative of the Foundation for Educational Exchange between Canada and the United States of America (Fulbright Canada). The STEM award, which is a three-year award valued at \$120,000 (tuition, fees, and an annual stipend of \$20,000), is the counterpart to Fulbright's International Science and Technology award for foreign students coming to the United States. It is open to students in the areas of Science, Technology, Engineering and Math (complete list available on web site).
