
AROUND CAMPUS



Jax State student-athletes continue to succeed both on the fields and in the classroom, achieving a **record-setting 3.418 cumulative grade point average** for the 2025 fall term. Coming off the athletic department's best overall academic year in 2024-25, Gamecock student-athletes improved to punch in the highest Fall GPA on record to begin 2025-26. The 3.418 combined GPA continues a rising trend that saw Jax State earn a 3.360 in Fall 2024, preceded by a 3.269 in 2023.
