This checklist is designed to assist the Biology Major in making reasonable progress towards satisfying these requirements.</p> <p>Non-Thesis option requires a minimum of 36 credit hours, of which 18hr must be at the 500 level, and the completion of an acceptable original paper and a comprehensive examination. Students must maintain an overall 3.0 gpa for all courses attempted. No more than 6 credit hours of C work are allowed. Incomplete grades must be removed within 12 months. There is a 6 year limit to course work to complete this degree.</p> <p>The advisee needs to be aware that certain events can slow his/her progress towards graduating on time, such as: routinely dropping courses; failing to maintain an overall minimal GPA of 3.0 (B).</p> <p>¹BY 595 should be taken during the semester that an acceptable original research paper is completed. That semester should be the one in which you intend on graduating and taking your comprehensive examination. Last, you must contact the Associate Dean of the College of Graduate Studies for an appointment prior to your graduating.</p> <p>²BY 415/415G or its equivalent is recommended. Graduate students cannot count undergraduate BY 415 as credits for graduate hours.</p>
