Welcome to Pre-K #Growing Gamecocks Family

We are so excited for your child to be in the JSU Pre-K Program this coming 2025-2026 school year! Please review the following information as it contains important dates. If you have any questions, you can call or email the Child Development Center (CDC).

Please start gathering the documents that are needed to register your child. You **MUST** have the following to register copy of birth certificate, copy of social security card, 3 proofs of residency (1 deed/lease/mortgage, and 2 utility bills), **original** immunization form (not a copy), parent's photo ID, and (if applicable) custody records. We must have these copies onsite, so please bring them to Meet the Teacher. Do not drop off at the office before or during the summer. Please follow the link to upload your child's birth certificate/proof of residency in ALACEED if you did not do it when preregistering your child during the open registration. https://prek.alaceed.alabama.gov

Your child will NOT be able to begin Pre-K until their birth certificate and proof of residency is uploaded in the above website.

We do not offer lunch, so you are responsible for packing your child's lunch and a snack daily. Pack items that do not need to be warmed. Thermoses are a great way to keep food warm while not requiring a microwave. A drinking thermos that locks will allow your child with a way to refill their cup. We do offer a filtered water refilling station.

Pre-K is free to Alabama residence. We do offer aftercare from 2:30-6:00 for \$20 a day. You are only charged when your child attends.

Dates to Remember:

- Mandatory Orientation for parents (no children) August 4th at 4:00-5:00. You can bring all supplies and paperwork at that time.
- Pre-K Meet the Teacher will be August 5th from 2:00pm-3:00pm (last names A-L) and 3:00pm-4pm (last names M-Z).
- We will begin school using a stagger start. If your child's last name begins with A L you will attend Wednesday, August 6th from 7:30am 2:00pm, but not Thursday. Everyone on Friday, Aug. 8th.
- M Z will attend Thursday, August 7th from 7:30am 2:00pm. Everyone will begin Friday, August 8th. Everyone begins on Friday, Aug. 8th.

August 4th: Orientation (Parents only)

August 5th: Meet the Teacher check above for times.

August 6^{th} : A – L: Half the class will attend from 7:30 - 2:00.

August 7th: M - Z: Half the class will attend from 7:30 - 2:00.

August 8th: ALL STUDENTS ATTEND from 7:30 - 2:00

Stagger Start allows a small group of students to come each day. On your child's designated day, we will get to know each other, we will introduce them to classroom and school procedures, and we will allow them to explore items in centers.

Our car line begins at 2:00pm and ends at 2:15pm. If we are not informed of your delay, your child will be taken to aftercare, and you will be responsible for paying the \$20 aftercare fee. If you have any questions or concerns, please feel free to reach out to your child's teacher.
