Submitting Your Documentation

Confirmation: A confirmation that your application was successfully submitted will appear at the top of the page.

Upload Documentation: If you already have documentation that is ready to be submitted, type the name of what you are wishing to upload (e.g., Medical Documentation, IEP, etc.) into the File Title Box. Then select the file you wish to upload using the "Choose File" button. Once you have selected your file click the button that says "Upload Documentation".

Upload Later: If you do not have the documentation with you in an electronic format or wish to submit it at a later date, click the "Upload Documentation Later" button.
