

Undergraduate Major in Special Education Collaborative Teacher K-6 and Special Education Collaborative Teacher 6-12

The Bachelor of Science in Education (BSE) in Special Education Collaborative Teacher K-6 and Special Education Collaborative Teacher 6-12 is one major with a dual certification component. Completion of this program of study coupled with the state-required testing and minimum GPA of 2.50 in three areas (overall, teaching field, and professional studies) will result in eligibility for dual certification in two teaching fields: Special Education Collaborative Teacher K-6 and Special Education Collaborative Teacher 6-12. The major cannot be separated by teaching field and candidates must pursue the course of study for the dual certification. The Alabama State Board of Education requires two separate checklists, however, it is important to note that the two checklists comprise one major.
