3. Early Childhood/Elementary and Special Education Candidates will be assessed an additional time during EED 339 and SPE 341 between Benchmarks Two and Three.

4. The trio of common measures will be administered at selectivity points: CLP + COBS at Benchmarks Two, Three, and Four, TCDA at Benchmarks One, Two, Three and Four, Praxis and edTPA© are program completion requirements.
