

FCS 441 Practicum in Hospitality and Culinary Management with The High Adventure Company

Criteria:

A minimum of 75 hours must be completed (40 hours completed at Jacksonville State). GPA - 2.85/4.00 (Overall).

A minimum of 30 hours must be completed in Family and Consumer Sciences and/or Business. GPA – 3.00/4.00

Student must have volunteer or work experience related to the field of study.

Student must be professional, mature, responsible/accountable, work independently, possess leadership potential, good communicator, and service oriented.

Student must be willing to travel and is responsible for travel expenses during the semester registered for practicum.

If accepted in the practicum, student must have medical insurance and provide proof of insurance.

If accepted in the practicum, student must complete an orientation program prior to beginning the practicum.

The High Adventure Company provides room and board for practicum students. In addition, students earn a stipend during the practicum.

Student earns a maximum of 6 semester credit hours per semester in FCS 441. Due to the time commitment and the fact that some practicum locations have unreliable internet service, students advised not to attempt additional coursework during the practicum.

Application Process:

Student must download and submit a completed application posted on the FCS Department Website to Lynn Steward, FCS Department Secretary, by January 15, 2018. A committee will review applications and notify students of approval no later than February 23, 2018. Practicum will be available 2018 Summer Semester (Full 12 Week) and 2018 Fall Semester.
