In alignment with Jacksonville State University's (JSU) mission to foster a learning-centered community and the 2023 Strategic Plan's commitments to "Discover," "Engage," and "Reach," Faculty Commons proposes the following strategic initiatives to enhance faculty support and development:

Strategic Initiatives:

1. Foster Collaborative Learning Communities

Actionable Steps:

- **Establish Interdisciplinary Groups:** Form faculty groups across disciplines to share best practices, engage in joint research projects, and discuss innovative teaching methods.
- **Organize Regular Meetings:** Schedule monthly or quarterly meetings to facilitate ongoing collaboration and knowledge exchange.
- **Provide Support for Joint Initiatives:** Offer resources and administrative assistance to support collaborative projects and research endeavors.

2. Enhance Professional Development Programs

Actionable Steps:

- **Conduct Needs Assessments:** Survey faculty to identify professional development needs and interests.

- 4. **Reporting:** Compile results into an annual assessment report to inform strategic planning for the office.

This plan and rubric serves as an internally developed office tool for continuous improvement, ensuring that Faculty Commons' initiatives effectively support faculty development and align with Jacksonville State University's mission and strategic goals.
