Welcome, new faculty, to the 2022 New Faculty Orientation (NFO) event, hosted by Faculty Commons, JSU's Center for Excellence in Teaching and Learning.

New Faculty Orientation is an on-campus event that provides all full-time faculty with the opportunity to meet important JSU figures including the President, Dr. Don C. Killingsworth Jr., the Provost and Senior Vice President for Academic Affairs, Dr. Christie Shelton, and the Vice Provost, Dr. Joe Walsh, as well as other members of the JSU community including representatives from various JSU offices and a variety of JSU faculty members. Activities that new faculty will experience at NFO include university browse sessions, informational sessions about faculty support services from various university representatives, a faculty Q&A panel, a JSU student profile delivered by the Dean of Students, and an opportunity to pick up faculty IDs and make faculty headshots.








Teaching Essentials Session
