

PELL PRORATION CHART

- Pell amounts are prorated based on the number of hours a student is enrolled in.
- The chart lists the proration percentages by the credit hour. 12 or more hours is considered full-time and therefore full Pell.



Credit Hours	Pell Proration
12 (or more)	100%
11	92%
10	83%
9	75%
8	67%
7	58%
6	50%
5	42%
4	33%
3	25%
2	17%
1	8%

Examples:

- Student A is enrolled in 12 hours and their Fall Pell award amount is \$3698
 - Based on the chart above, they can receive 100% of award amount based on enrollment
 - $\$3698 \times 100\% = \3698 paid in Pell
- Student B is enrolled in 10 hours and their Fall Pell award amount is \$3698
 - Based on the chart above, they can receive 83% of award amount based on enrollment
 - $\$3698 \times 83\% = \3069 paid in Pell
- Student C is enrolled in 5 hours and their Fall Pell award amount is \$1440
 - Based on the chart above, they can receive 42% of award amount based on enrollment
 - $\$1440 \times 42\% = \605 paid in Pell
- Student D is enrolled in 2 hours and their Fall Pell award amount is \$1235
 - Based on the chart above, they can receive 17% of award amount based on enrollment
 - $\$1235 \times 17\% = \210 paid in Pell
