DR. KENNETH G. BODIFORD

Director of Bands and Associate Professor of Music

For nearly three decades, I have proudly served as the Director of Bands at JSU, starting in 1994. As I embark on my 30th year in this esteemed position, I reflect on the incredible journey that brought me here. Being an alumnus of JSU myself, becoming the director of the band program has truly been a dream come true. Throughout my tenure, I have witnessed the confirmation of four university presidents, three fine arts deans, four music department heads, and the appointment of eight football coaches. It has been a rollercoaster of highs and lows, but I have remained steadfast in my commitment to the students and the art of music.

My educational journey has been instrumental in shaping me into the teacher and mentor I am today. After earning my Bachelor of Science in Music Education from JSU, I pursued further academic excellence at East Carolina University, where I obtained my master's degree.

Determined to expand my knowledge and expertise, I went on to complete my doctorate at The University of Alabama in instrumental conducting.
