DR. JENNIE VAUGHN

Integrated Studies Graduate Program Director, **Assistant Professor of English**

I am a 2-time JSU graduate, BA in Communication and English 1997 and an MSE in English Language Arts 2010. During my Masters work, I had 3 small children and a busy life.
