## Honors Lecture - 22052 - UH 101 - 001

Mapping, Place, & Identity: Place is a key element to our lives. We experience our everyday lives through the people we come into contact, the events we experience, and the places we explore. These experiences include the music we hear, the sound we explore as we walk across campus, and the sights we see, and places we experience. In this course, students will learn how to explore their identity and the identities we create in a place through sound, visuals, and other sense for a complete sensory experience. As part of the course, students will learn how to use ArcGIS Online to create maps and display their research through a spatial platform. At the end of the course, students will conduct a community research project, in which they will choose a community partner or other entity to provide a spatial perspective for that group. An example could be mapping the campus, creating a sound walk of the city, or even conducting interviews of local community members on a topic and creating an interactive map.

**Honors Book Club - 20019 - UH 202 - 001**

Extra! Extra! Read all about it! This course will explore hundreds of "underground" newspapers which were created by Vietnam-Era counterculture youth during 1965-1974 and sold on street corners in all regions of the United States. Students will become familiar with protest literature published in alternative "rags" such as the East Village Other, The Great Speckled Bird, the Berkeley Barb, the San Francisco Oracle, and hundreds more. Some of the topics heavily covered in these papers are Civil Rights, Women's Liberation, the American Indian Movement, LGBT rights, the New Left, the Environmental Movement, Communal living, "hippie" lifestyle, sex, drugs, rock n' roll, the rise of underground comix, and anti-war demonstrations. Students will utilize the Underground Press Syndicate's (UPS) Underground Newspaper Collection which includes over 800 newspapers created by young people during the 1960s. While the topics studied are very liberal, no political viewpoints are in any way promoted.

UH 300: Honors Special Topics: Interdisciplinary: Monstrous Science This interdisciplinary course uses scientific, literary, historical, and philosophical approaches to understand how humankind reacts to and is impacted by scientific advances. We will frame discussions of "Frankenstein science," such as genetically modified organisms and cloning, with reading and discussion of Mary Shelley's Frankenstein, the first science fiction novel. This course brings together science and the humanities to illuminate ethical considerations and examine mistrust of scientific information and progress, including reactions to the pandemic and potential scientific solutions.
