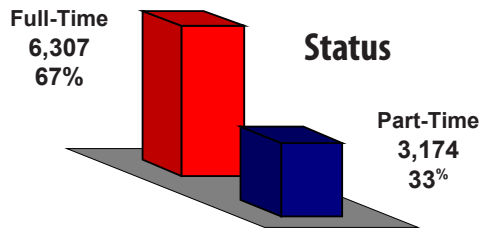

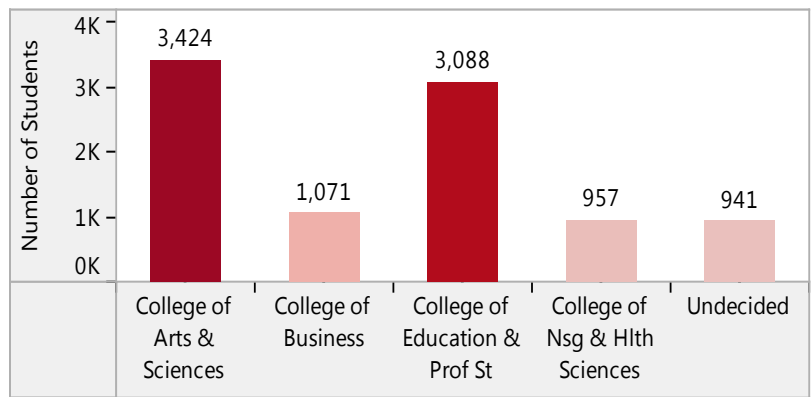

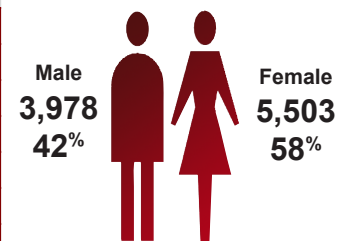
Enrollment by College

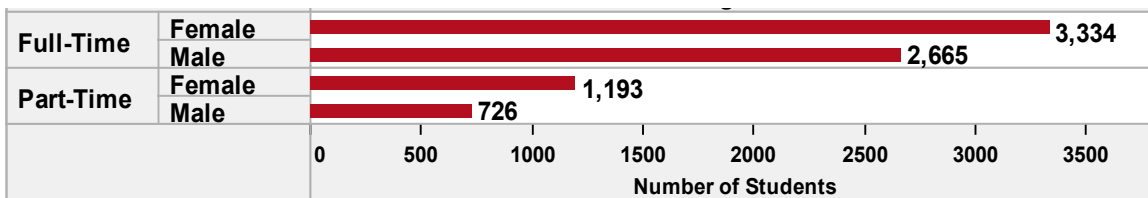

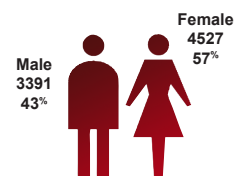

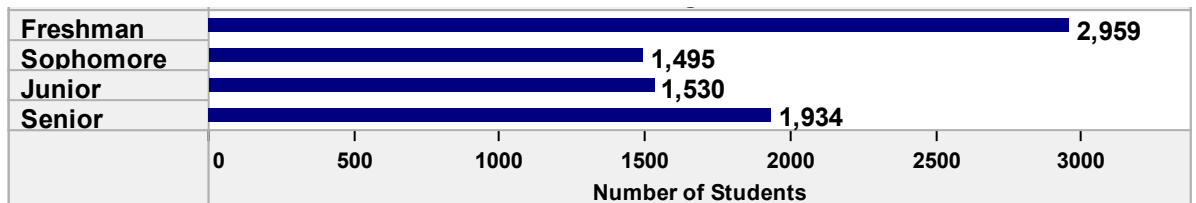
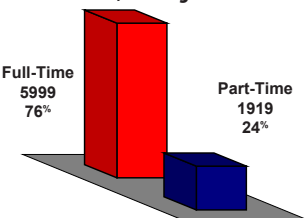

Gender, Undergraduates



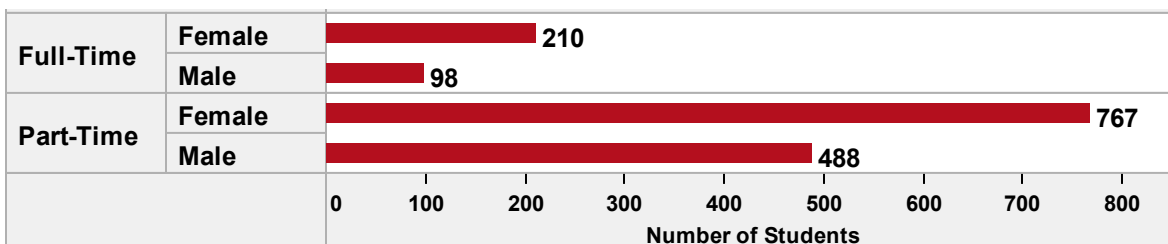
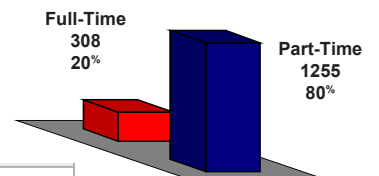
Status, Undergraduates

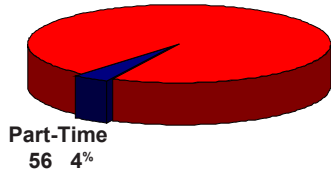

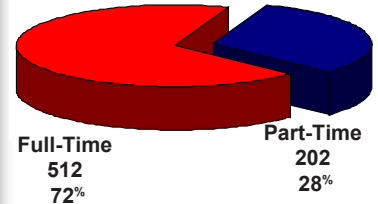
Gender, First-Time Freshmen

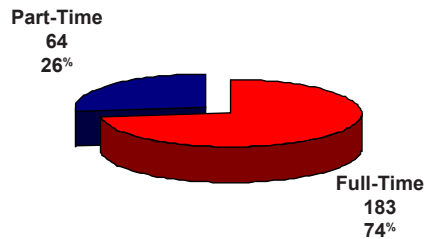

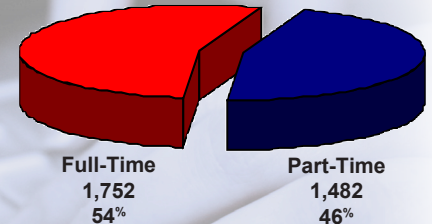

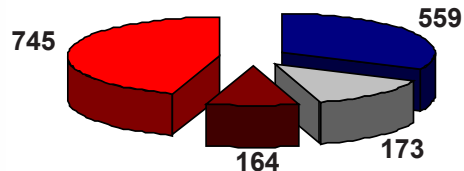
