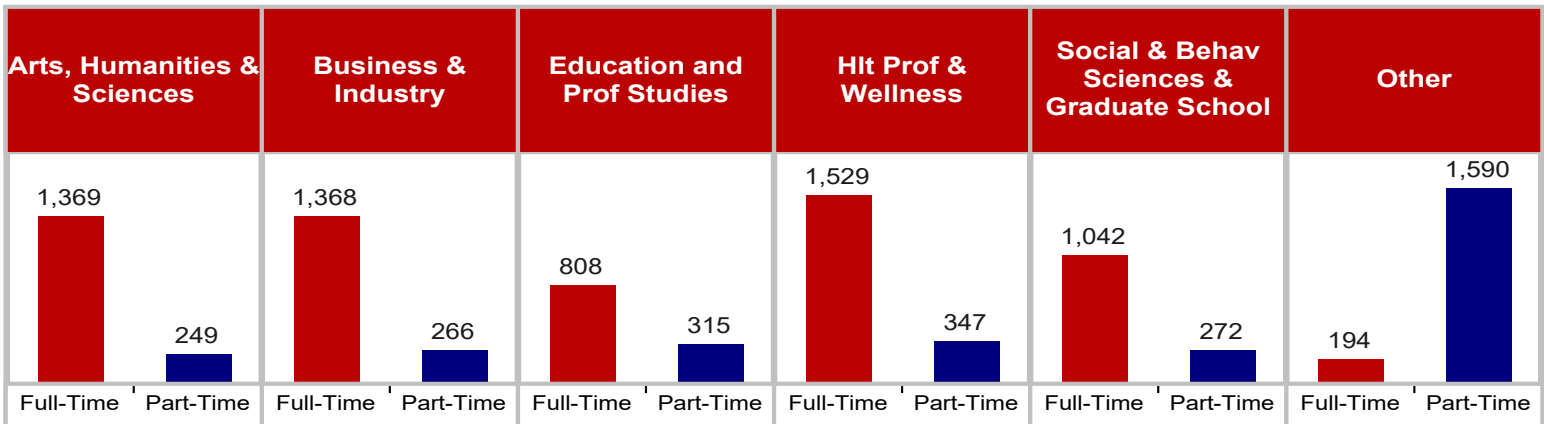

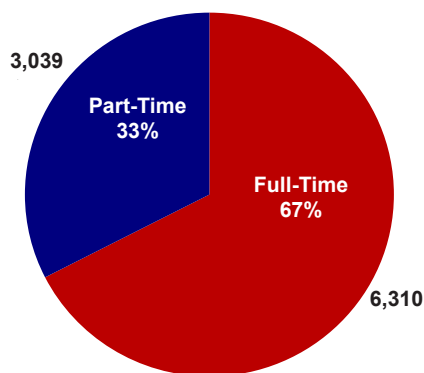

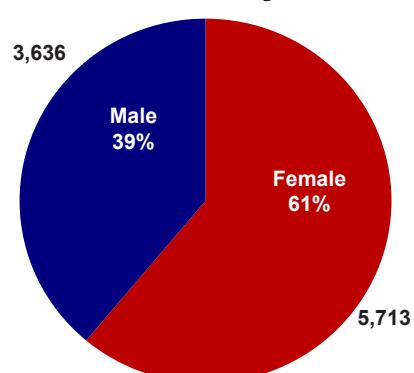
Enrollment by College and Status



Enrollment by Status



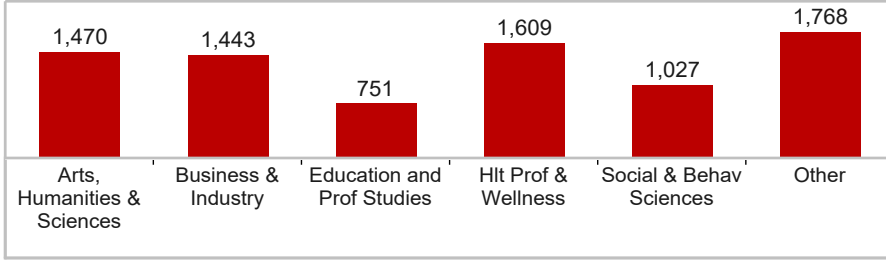
Enrollment by Gender



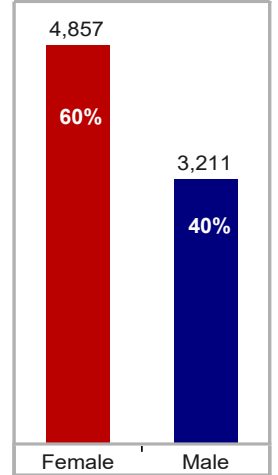
Undergraduate Enrollment 8,068

Undergraduate students make up **86%** of JSU's total Spring 2026 enrollment.

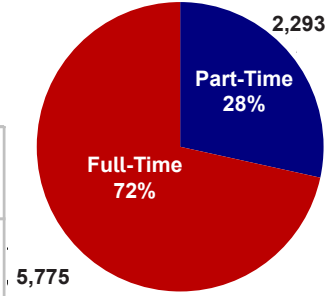

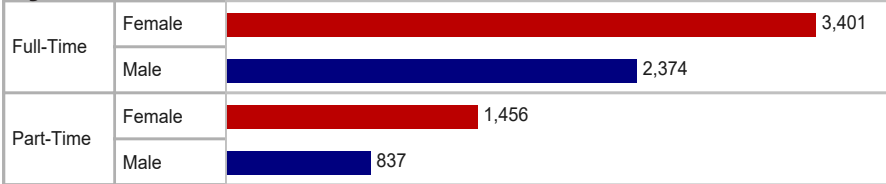
By Gender



By Status



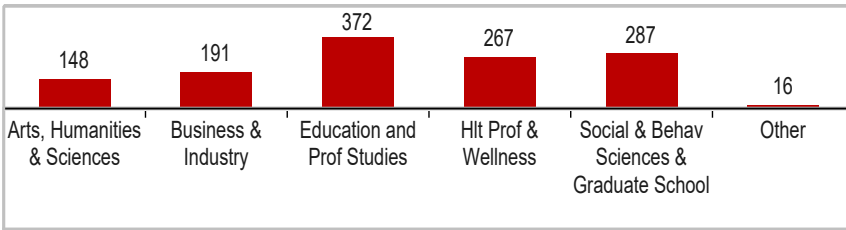
By Gender and Status



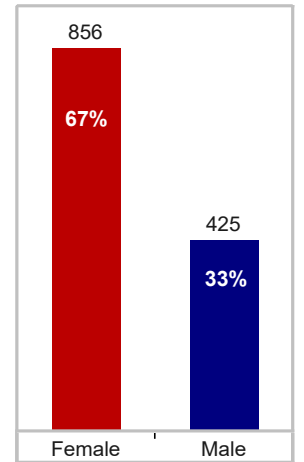
Graduate Enrollment 1,281*

Graduate students make up **14%** of JSU's total Spring 2026 enrollment.

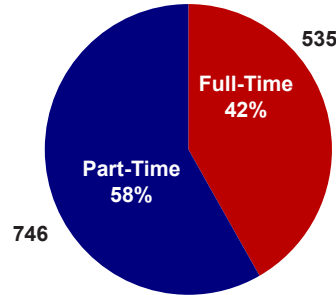

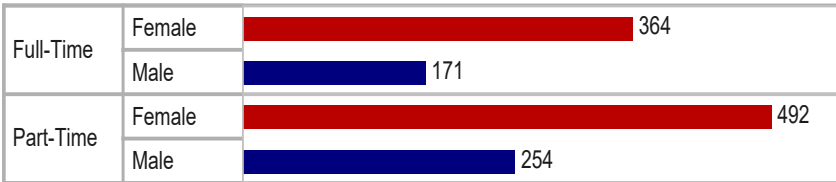
By Gender

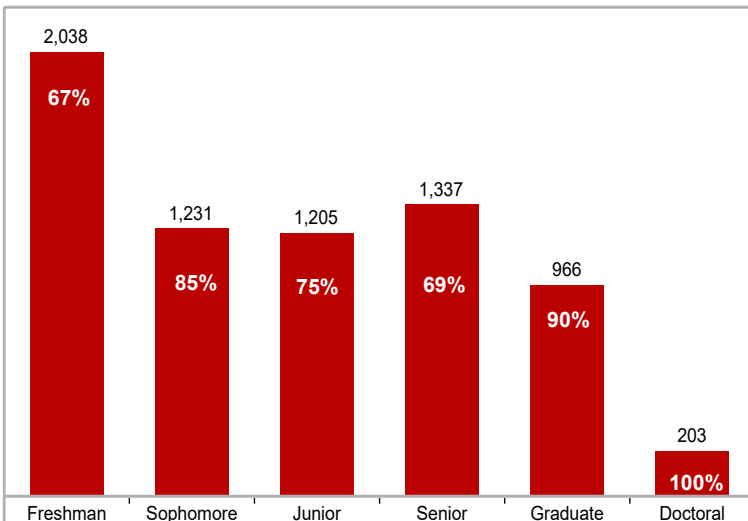

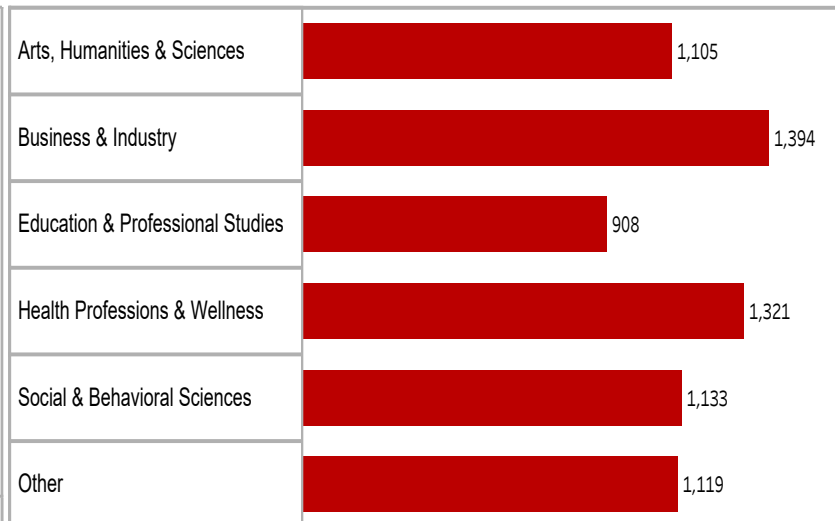
Distance Education*
