Course and Range Location: Northeast Alabama Law Enforcement Academy, 100 Gamecock Drive, Anniston, AL 36205.

Program Description: This training builds upon foundational marksmanship skills and introduces advanced considerations relevant to field application. Instruction addresses decision-making, problem-solving, observation, communication, and accountability within constrained environments. Performance standards remain enforced throughout the program. The training is intensive and includes low-light instructional components.

Ammunition: Bring match grade ammunition. Non-match grade ammo will not hold the groups we are required in the learned outcomes.

Weapons: Students should already know the weapon, optics and have a basic understanding of their gear. Personally/custom built rifles should be checked by professional armorers to ensure stock to barrel fits are in the correct tolerances. Scopes should be affixed correctly without canting. Zero your rifle prior to attending.

Qualifications: They are HARD.

During classroom time: Students will construct a makeshift ghillie hat and upper-body concealment using instructor-provided materials.

Each student needs to bring:

- ✓ **Camo Boonie Hat or Wide-Brim Safari / Field Hat**
- ✓ Camo Field Shirt (Ripstop), old BDU top, Camo Smock / Combat Jacket
- ✓ Quality spotting scope, wrap around eye protection and foam hearing protection
- ✓ Note pad, pen and water, Cleaning gear for all weapons
- ✓ Shooting mat or blanket, Wet weather gear, bug spray, sun block, etc
- ✓ Something to cover your head (large scarf, towel or cloth) to cover your head

Weapons

- ✓ Rifle should be capable of holding 1-inch groups at 100 yards.
- ✓ Pistol with holster and at least three magazines 100 Rounds *(yes, that says pistol)
- ✓ Scoped Rifle (Bolt or Semi Auto with magnification or scope) and 250 Match Grade Rounds
