WHY A MPA DEGREE?

The MPA degree is a flexible degree geared towards professionals working with the public sector and non-profit organizations. However, many private organizations contract with federal, state or local agencies. Having an understanding of the intersection of public and private sectors is important to a successful career. The MPA program has four concentrations: Administrative Management, Criminal Justice, Emergency Management, and Political Science (100% online). These concentrations allow students to focus on a career path that is best suited to their interests. The designation of an MPA will immediately set you apart. When employers see MPA after your name, they recognize that you have skills and knowledge that other applicants may lack. This may be the competitive advantage needed to land you a job or promotion.

HOW LONG WILL IT TAKE TO COMPLETE THE DEGREE?

The MPA degree at JSU requires 39 credit hours. How long it takes will depend on how many credits you take each semester. We offer courses during the Fall, Spring and Summer semesters.



CONCENTRATIONS



All students are required to complete 39 credit hours. With four concentrations, students will be able to focus their studies in areas that fit with their career goals! All our concentrations promote the values and ideals of the public good. There are many areas in which the public and private spheres converge. Our students learn skills that allow them to navigate and succeed no matter which sector they choose.

Most classes are offered hybrid (mostly on campus) and online to accommodate student preferences.
