JSU offers students two different nurse practitioner programs.

Both programs require students to earn clinical hours throughout the last four semesters of their MSN degree while working with a licensed preceptor.

Students must also take coursework in advanced pathophysiology, advanced pharmacology, and advanced physical assessment before beginning all clinical courses.
