Financial Aid/Scholarships

- Your student must maintain an institutional GPA of at least 2.0 and earn 66.7% (2/3) of all credit hours attempted to maintain their financial aid eligibility.
- Students must be enrolled in at least 12 credit hours each semester to receive their merit scholarship. Additionally, your student must earn 24 hours to have their merit scholarship renewed at the end of each academic year.

Housing Operations and Residence Life



Welcome Home, Gamecocks! We are excited to have your students join our residential communities this year and look forward to seeing them get connected on campus. Check out our move-in guide for more valuable information about living on campus, including a suggested packing list, move-in times, and helpful information for transitioning to campus.

If your student has not received their assignment yet, we are still working to confirm students and are receiving cancellations daily. Once your student has been assigned, they will receive an email to their JSU email address, and they will see their assignment on THD Self Service. They will not be able to move in until they receive an assignment; we will provide them with move-in instructions once assigned.

Be in the Know via Proxy

Do you want to know your student's tuition and fee charges or financial aid information? Do you want to access your student's schedule or grades?

As a parent, Jax State understands that you may be directly or indirectly involved in the payment of the student's account. We also know you may have questions about financial aid, scholarships, third party billing, due dates, final grades, schedule, etc. Most of the common questions can be answered by reviewing the websites of the Office of Financial Aid, Office of Student Accounts, and Office of the Registrar. We can answer any general questions.

When specific questions are asked, we must follow the federal regulations contained in FERPA (Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act).

The FERPA regulation limits the information we can disclose since the rights to the education record are transferred to the student once he/she/they attend a post-secondary institution. Jax State offers a process to assist you and the student when it comes to communicating specifically about an account or record. Your student may create a proxy for you and identify the areas you are granted access. The three areas are financial, financial aid, and academics. Your student also determines the length of time you are granted access.

When proxy is being set up, an email will be sent to you using the email your student provided. There is an initial password provided in the first email. Verify the account using the link and password. You will create a new password. The second email you will receive will contain a passphrase. The passphrase is an identifier the student created. (Example – Cocky created Mascot as the passphrase for his proxy) When communicating with select offices, the **student number and the passphrase is required** to verify your identity. Please note that the criteria checked is the only information we can disclose once you have been verified. (Example: This does not include individual assignments in courses.)

Without the student number and passphrase, we will refer you back to your student.

JSU Dining

The meal plan options below will help you and your student make the right selection for them or assist in explaining how each of the options work. For additional information, please visit our <u>website</u>.

Jax Cash

- Required for freshmen and sophomore students taking 6 or more credit hours who do not reside in on-campus housing.
- A University fee of \$275 (\$302.50 after tax) assessed at the beginning of fall and spring semesters.
- May be used at all on-campus dining locations Funds roll over from term to term per academic year (Fall > Spring > Summer).

CockyBucks

- Optional dollars available for purchase and will be added to the students JCard
- \$50 minimum deposit required
- May be used at all on-campus dining locations in addition to offcampus eateries such as Mason's BBQ and Struts of Jacksonville
- Funds roll over from term to term until cardholder graduates or leaves JSU
- May be purchased on your MyJaxState portal under ID Card Management

Meal Plans with Flex Dollars

- Residential and Commuter meal plans are available
- Meal plans include meal swipes to be used at Jack Hopper Dining

- Hall Flex dollars can be used at all on-campus food locations
- Voluntary flex plans are available for commuters
- Weekly meal plans run Monday-Sunday and do not roll over to following week Block meal plans must be used within the semester they are purchased
- JSU housing residents select a meal plan option on the JSU Campus Dining page
- May be purchased on your MyJaxState portal under ID Card Management
