Other Requirements:

- Students must complete a total of 40 hours of AHSS coursework beyond the Jax MIX General Education Curriculum.
 - Please see the JSU Undergraduate Catalog's entry for the [Bachelor of Arts in Integrated Studies](#) for more details, including a list of Arts, Humanities, Social Sciences, and Science (AHSS) subjects
- At least half of the bachelor's degree (60 hours) must be taken at a four-year institution
- At least 25% of the bachelor's degree must be taken at JSU
- A minimum of 36 hours must be taken at the 300/400 level with a C or better
- No more than 46 hours of nontraditional credit will be accepted
- JSU does not accept the following types of coursework for transfer: co-op, preceptorship, internship, clinical, practicum, directed study, or seminar.
- Each student's transcript will be evaluated for additional general education transfer credits. Additional Technical Specialty coursework may be transferred in as INS electives, as needed, in accord with all current JSU policies and practices.
