



BACHELOR OF ARTS IN INTEGRATED STUDIES

Service Members and Veterans will find that the Bachelor of Arts in Integrated Studies (INS) is a flexible degree program. Designed for students who want a custom-built program tailored to meet their personal and career goals, the program can be completed entirely online and allows college credit for both military and work experience. In this program, students build their own academic curriculum, an option not found in most traditional majors. This multidisciplinary, individualized approach helps set students apart while building skills needed for today's job market.

DEGREE REQUIREMENTS

60 HOURS of general education courses

15 HOURS of individually designed upper-level curriculum or internship

21 HOURS of 300/400 level courses in arts, humanities, science, social science and other classes approved by INS advisor

24 HOURS of general electives (by advisement)
 – 3-10 hours for military experience
 – 3-15 hours for work experience

= 120 TOTAL HOURS
