Research Currently in Progress

"Trauma Transition Tool (T3) Assessment" (On-Going).

Have found a graphic artist that can transition tool from rough draft to a replicable product to be field tested. Have several agencies interested in testing this tool once replication stage is complete.

Developed a Trauma Transition Tool during MS course in Trauma, Crisis, and Grief Counseling at Mercer University. The tool is a hybrid of art therapy, mental health assessment, and action oriented goals.

The tool is currently at graphic artist for a professional and final rendition for print. The artist, Tammy Hotchkiss, will then turn the tool from a print to electronic format.

While the tool is printed, a survey will be sent to mental health counselors currently treating victims of trauma or PTSD. The assessment is a modified Delphi. Once the purposeful survey has been sent and participants have been identified, a four hour training session will occur. The consent forms will be signed and the tool will be explained. Three months after the tool has been in use, a survey will be sent to the participants to determine ease of use and acceptance of the tool by the counselors.

Six months after the tool has been in use, I will arrange an interview that will consist of phenomenologically based questions on the experiences the counselors had with clients that used the tool. The data will be reviewed and analyzed concerning the functionality of the tool.

T3 tool has come out of graphics and is underway for a Copyright. Provisional Patent may be following quickly. Have a potential for 3 Tier 1 Research Institutes and one national research center interested in testing this tool and model for trauma victims.

Results will be written and submitted for publication.
