

Student Government Association Tailgate Rules and Regulations

- The tailgating area on the Quad is reserved for Registered Student Organizations (RSOs) only. Access to the tailgating area for outside groups and organizations must be approved by the Dean of Students Office.
- Tailgate spots are first come, first served once you arrive for check in. You must check in with SGA before going to your tailgate spot.
- If you are using a tent or table from SGA, you must leave the equipment at the end of the tailgate. If you damage the equipment, you will be responsible for replacing it.
- The Quad tailgate area will close at kickoff of the game. Students, student organizations, faculty, staff, and/or visitors will be responsible for cleaning their area. Failure to clean area may result in fines and loss of tailgate privileges. Jacksonville State University & the Student Government Association are not responsible for any lost, damaged, or stolen property in the Tailgate Area.
- No loud speakers that disrupt the experience of other tailgaters.
- No vehicles are allowed on the Quad in the tailgating area.
- You are permitted to bring food and drinks.
- You must follow all policies outlined in the Code of Student Conduct and the Code of Student Organization Conduct, including the Alcohol and Other Drug Policy. If alcohol is present, it must be in a cup or koozie. RSOs cannot distribute alcohol at the tailgate. No glass bottles allowed in the tailgating area.
- Disruptive and unsafe behavior, as defined in the Code of Student Conduct, will not be tolerated.
- Individuals and/or RSOs who participate in misconduct may be referred to the Office of Community Standards.
- The SGA and Dean of Students Office can revoke tailgate privileges from any student organization at any time if the rules and regulations are not followed.
